About us

Our family business was established by Harry Davenport in 1947, initially growing flowers and vegetables and selling them locally until he opened a green grocers in Barnton. Bridge Farm was bought and the land used to grow, but the house was rented to Eileen and Hank Day who ran an excellent restaurant from there. In fact Bridge Farm is believed to be the first place in the UK to serve chicken in a basket!

In Dec 2006 Davenports opened the farm shop, which has already achieved multi-award winning status.

The tea room opened 30 Nov 2007, although this wasn't the first tea room in the family. Ian's Grandfather had a tea room, bakery and shops in Northwich during the 1930's and 40's (pictured below).
